DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT



In Mid-March of 2020, TARC received notice from the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) that due to COVID-19 being a far greater threat to people with intellectual and developmental disabilities, aging, and complex medical conditions. All providers were to close their locations and services, excluding our round the clock residential services that included our community homes and independent living individuals. The Executive Leadership Team continued to work throughout the

pandemic. Although the state moved into Phase 1 in May, LDH did not give permission to providers to open services to individuals with IDD until further notice. At this time, TARC made the decision to reopen all businesses to provide jobs for TARC employees, and most importantly, continue running our successful community businesses so that when our participants with IDD were officially allowed to return for services and employment, their jobs would be secure during and after the pandemic. In June, TARC was able to start phasing back in, the individuals we serve.

Throughout 2020, TARC continued to keep in touch with all participants via weekly phone calls. The Vocational and Supported Employment divisions returned to work in mid-July. Day Habilitation participants returned in small numbers on December 1, 2020.

Although 2020 has been a devastating year, TARC has maintained operating at full capacity in the 13 community businesses supported by the local community. Thrift store sales have soared, lawns continued to be cut, janitorial contracts were kept, the TARC Restaurant and Gift Shop was open and followed all government guidelines, Grand Designs boomed with orders, Houma Grown salsa and pepper jelly flew off grocery shelves, and all other aspects of this organization maintained integrity and safety.

KUDOS to staff who came to work during the most trying times! A BIG THANK YOU to Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government for helping with COVID-19 supplies and looking out for our welfare. Another THANK YOU to the TARC Board of Directors for making it possible to meet the needs of our organization in 2020.
